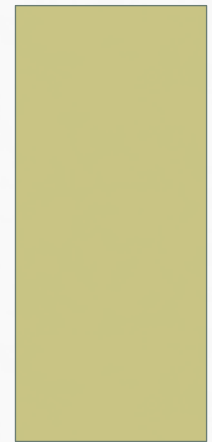

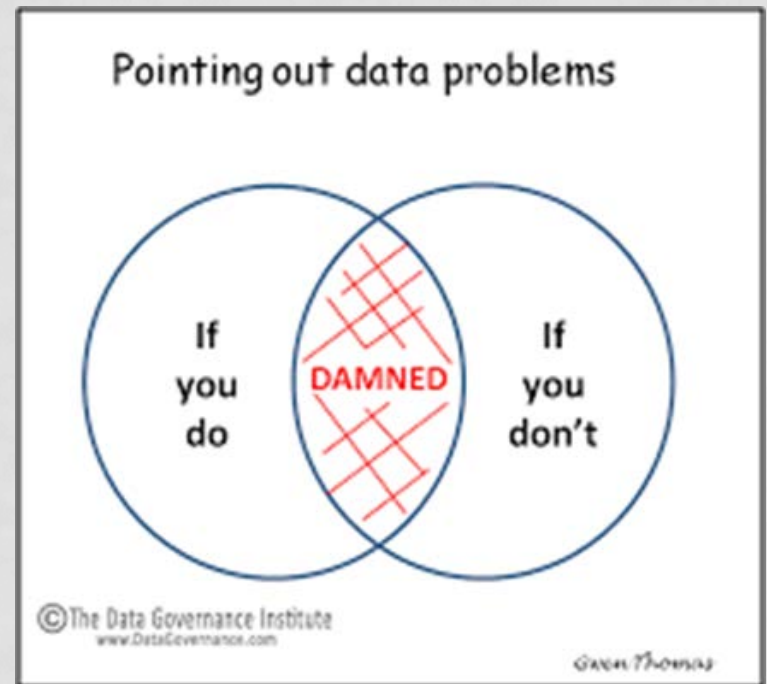

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- Due at 6-month and year-end and submitted using our online system
- Provides year-to-date data on the proposed deliverables submitted in your grant application(s)
- Reviewed by staff and Sector Leaders; Feedback, support and monitoring provided as needed
- COFU reserves the right to request data regarding the organization throughout the life of the grant at any time
